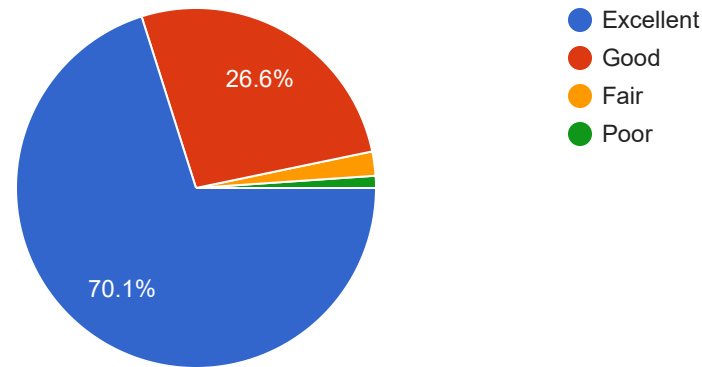

Holistic development of students is ensured by participation of students in various sports, cultural and co-curricular activities organized throughout the year.



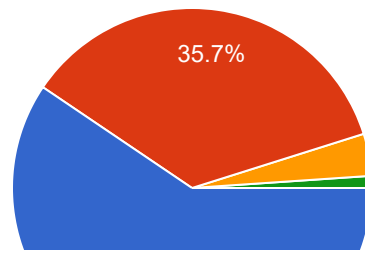

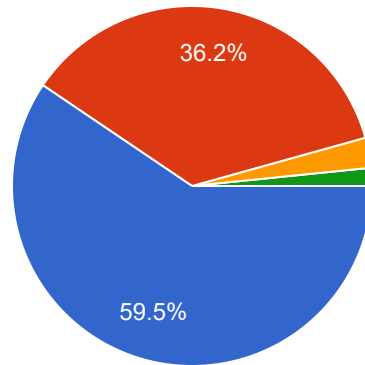

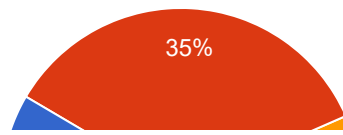

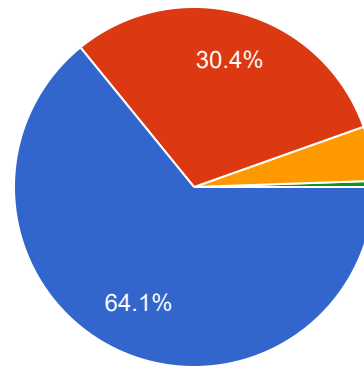

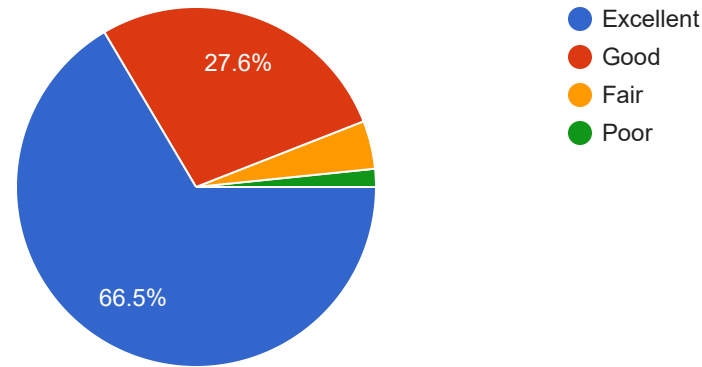

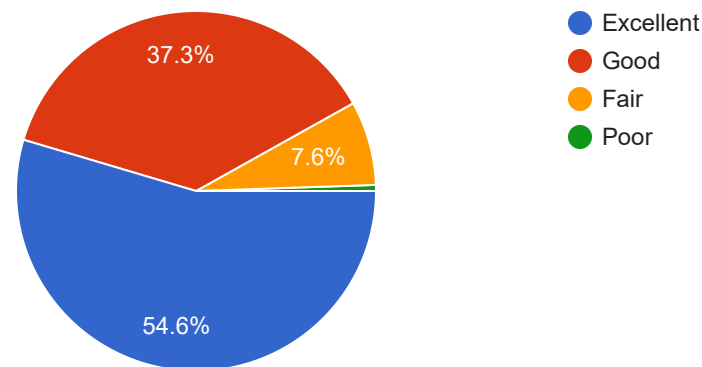
How do you rate the outcomes that your ward has achieved from the courses?

How do you rate the transparency of the evaluation system in the College?

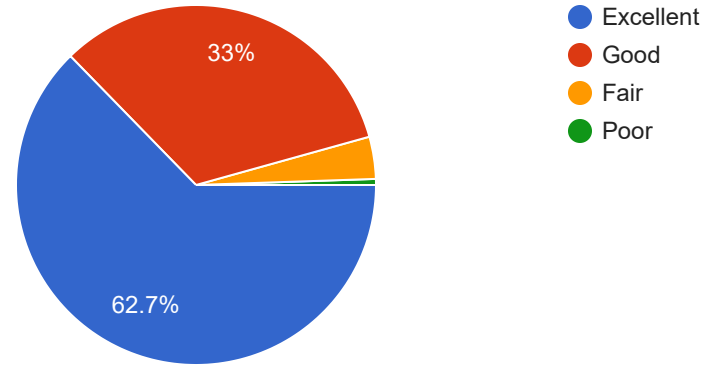
