

ANTI-RAGGING CELL

Objective:

To maintain a safe, disciplined, and ragging-free environment and to protect the dignity and well-being of all students.

About the Cell:

The Anti-Ragging Cell is constituted in strict compliance with the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the regulations of the University Grants Commission (UGC) to prohibit, prevent, and eliminate ragging in all its forms. Ragging is a cognizable offence and is strictly punishable under the provisions of the Indian Penal Code and applicable laws.

The institution adopts a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging and is committed to ensuring an environment that upholds the dignity, safety, and fundamental rights of every student. The Anti-Ragging Cell is empowered to take immediate and stringent action against any individual or group found involved in ragging or abetting such acts.

The Cell functions as a vigilant and responsive body, ensuring continuous monitoring, prompt redresses of complaints, and strict enforcement of anti-ragging regulations. Any incident of ragging shall invite disciplinary as well as legal action, including suspension, expulsion, and initiation of criminal proceedings, as per law.

What is Ragging?

Ragging includes any act- verbal, written, or physical—that causes embarrassment, harassment, or harm to a student. This may include teasing, bullying, rude behaviour, or creating fear among fresher's or fellow students.

Functions of the Cell:

- Promote awareness about anti-ragging laws and policies
- Ensure strict monitoring across campus premises
- Encourage a healthy and friendly student environment
- Provide a platform for students to report grievances
- Take immediate and appropriate action on complaints

Anti-Ragging Measures:

- Awareness programs and orientation sessions for students
- Display of anti-ragging guidelines on campus
- Formation of Anti-Ragging Squad for regular monitoring
- Confidential complaint and reporting mechanism

Punishments for Ragging:

Ragging is a serious offence. Students found guilty may face:

- Suspension or expulsion from the institution
- Cancellation of admission

- Withholding of scholarships or benefits
- Filing of FIR and legal action as per law
